**Question: Why is the dues structure being changed?**

The growth in our membership has outgrown the current dues structure. The new dues structure will streamline membership renewals to correspond to an annual date also will provide a clearer understanding of available fiscal resources for planning purposes.

**Question: When do the new rates go into effect?**

The 2010 institutional due rates go into effect September 2010. All institution members will receive a renewal letter in September asking them to renew their annual membership for the period of October, 2010 through September, 2011.

The chapter membership dues will go into effect September 2011. This will allow local chapters to implement annual local due rates which include the national rate of \$10 per members and discuss with members the dues structure changes.

**Question: What is the annual institutional dues rate?**

The 2010 annual institutional dues are \$450 per institution.

**Question: What does the institutional membership provide?**

The institutional membership provides access to professional development and scholarship opportunities for women at your institution.

**Question: What if I have already paid my institutional membership this year under the old structure?**

All member institutions will receive a renewal notification September 2010 showing the new annual renewal rate of \$450.

If your institution renewed its annual membership on or after July 1, 2010, the renewal rate for September 2010 will reflect a \$300 discount and your institution will be required to pay the additional \$150 to pay the full \$450 rate.

If your institution renewed its annual membership prior to July 1, 2010, your institution will be required to pay the full \$450 renewal rate.

**Question: What is the annual individual dues rate?**

Local chapters of AAWCC will be required to submit \$10 per member to the national organization on an annual basis.

**Question: What if I have already paid my individual membership this year under the old structure?**

If you have renewed your individual membership this year under the old structure, you will continue to receive the same benefits you have had access to prior to the dues structure change.

**Question: What about members who do not belong to a chapter?**

Members of AAWCC who may not belong to a chapter or section may join AAWCC for a \$45.00 fee directly to AAWCC National.

**Question: Why don't I need to pay for an individual membership this year?**

It is our expectation that chapters and sections will need to work directly with their members to establish a local dues structure over the course of the year. It is our hope by not asking individual members to pay the national renewal rate; members will be more willing to contribute to local dues which will include the \$10 national renewal rate.

**Question: How/when will our new members (after September 1, 2010) be recognized as national members?**

As part of our current process, chapters and sections are required to report membership information on an annual basis. For members who join AAWCC chapters or sections after September 1, 2010, these members will be considered national members upon joining and will need to be included in the annual report at the end of the year with payment of their national membership dues.
