

I'm happy to report that the AACC Board did undertake the issue of affirmative action, in part because of AAW's resolution, which was supported by the other councils you had contacted. The decision of the Board was to reaffirm its own long-standing policy as well as its commitment to affirmative action generally, rather than adopting the new language in your resolution. Attached is the resolution passed at the meeting and a copy of the earlier policy. These will be distributed to all AACC members and articles will appear in the *Community College Times* and the *Journal*. I believe the higher education organizations gathered at 1 Dupont Circle plan to issue some sort of joint statement as well. Seems like you can count this as yet another of AAW's triumphs.
