AACC Resolution on Welfare Reform

Whereas the majority of welfare recipients are women and children and

Whereas education and training are the best means for welfare recipients to achieve self-sufficiency and

Whereas community colleges provide the most cost effective, high quality, comprehensive programs at times and places convenient to these students and

Whereas the time allowed to achieve education and training must be sufficient to accomodate family responsibilities, remedial work, counseling, assessment and other services,

Therefore, be it resolved that AACC supports federal welfare policies that allow recipients sufficient time to complete their education and training programs so long as they meet appropriate standards of academic progress.
