Thus, AAWCC would like to ask that the AACC Board of Directors consider our resolution at their next meeting and take appropriate action. Whether that action is to adopt the same or similar resolution, or identify another way of expressing its commitment, I will leave to your and your colleagues' judgement. However, some strong statement is necessary as soon as possible. In my state we already are feeling the backlash and broad based national support from our leading professional association is critical.
