Criteria and Process

2012-2013

- Scholarship Applications will include:
 - 1 page scholarship application
 - 1 page AAWCC Fact Sheet
 - 1 unofficial Transcript
- Scholarship scoring criteria:

Student applicants must have a letter of support from an AAWCC nationally recognized chapter.

 - 250 word essay (50 points)
 - GPA 3.2 or higher (20 points)
 - Financial Need (20 points)
 - Employment (5 points)
 - Extra -curricular activities (5 points)
- Scholarship applications should be available by January 1, 2012 at the following:
 - AAWCC Website
 - Through Regional Director
 - Through Board member
 - Financial aid offices at AAWCC Chapter colleges (Regional Directors should ensure this is sent.)
 - Foundation offices at AAWCC Chapter Colleges (Regional Directors should ensure this is sent.)
- Scholarship applications/due date information
 - Scholarships will be submitted to and one awarded by each Regional Director
 - Student applications will be due 3/02/12.
 - Regional Directors will notify the recipients in writing of the award.
 - Regional Directors will submit to Beverly Walker-Griffiea a copy of the recipient's rubric score sheet by 03/23/12 and will submit to the AAWCC Vice President for Communications any pictures and news articles for the AAWCC newsletter.
 - Regional Directors will request and pay for an official transcript for each awardee.
 - Beverly-Walker-Griffiea will notify Julie Huckestein by 04/06/12 for scholarship checks to be sent and AAWCC memberships to be awarded to recipients.
 - Beverly Walker-Griffiea will send by 04/13/12 congratulatory letters to college presidents notifying them of their winning student applicants and encouraging them to send a press release to the local newspaper.
